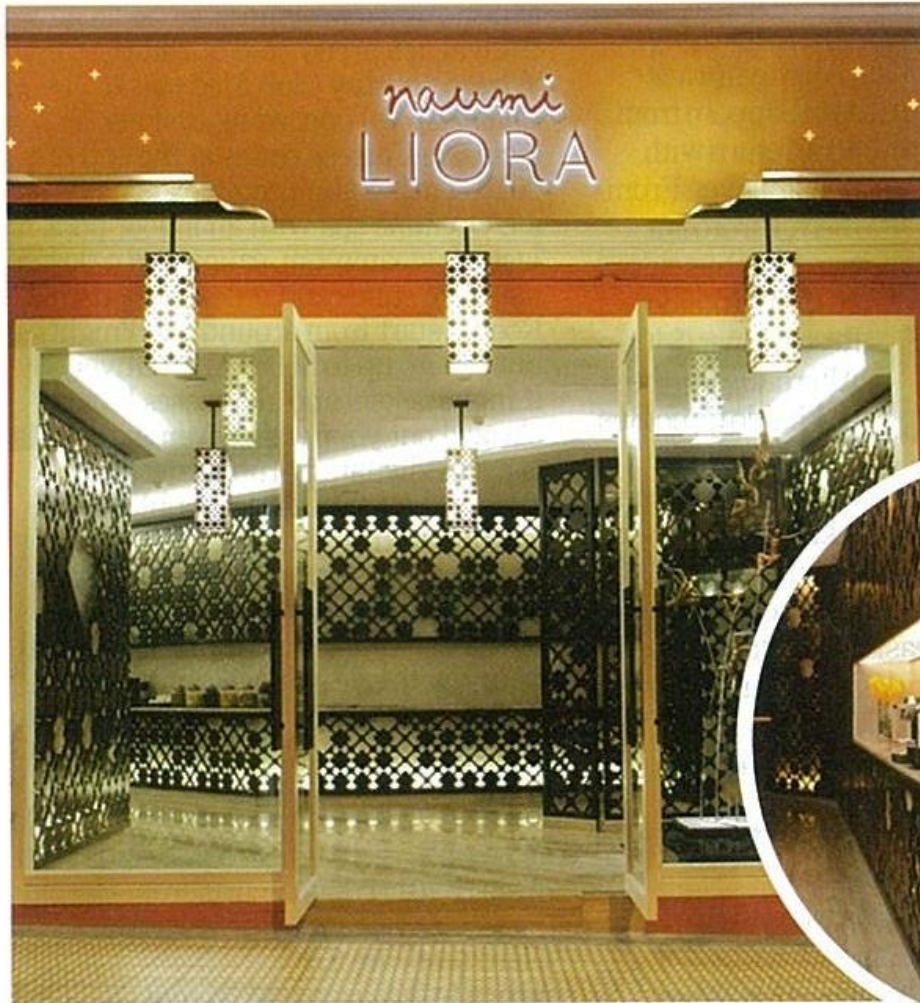


* Recently opened Naumi Liora



The second boutique hotel in Singapore for the Hind Group, the Naumi Liora is a name you might be familiar with because of its notable tenants Keong Saik Snacks (the restaurant provides breakfast exclusively for hotel guests) and The Library. Now the hotel is fully open for business, showcasing elements of traditional Peranakan design, from the lattice patterns to the preserved wooden flooring. There are three room categories – while the most basic, Liora Quaint (from \$380 per night), is only 25sqm and comes without a

window, there's a bit more room

in the Liora Porch suites (from \$580 per night), which

feature an outdoor space overlooking Duxton Plain Park. Of course, there are plenty of boutique touches throughout the hotel, such as CO Bigelow amenities in the bathrooms and a 24-hour Nibbles snack bar with teas, biscuits and even ice cream.
